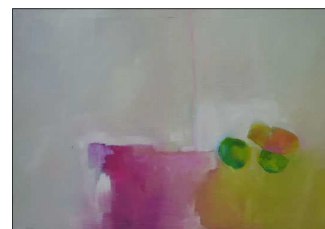

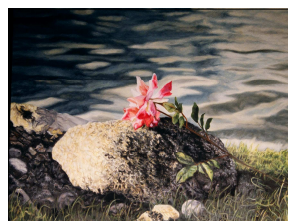

Twice yearly we offer a five day residential painting course where artists of any level will find inspiration and learn new skills in the stimulating and encouraging atmosphere of a small group with expert tuition. 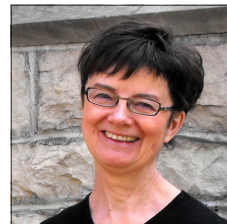
The Tutors
